The plaintiff is MSc student at the University of Kansas and CEO of Ruposi Bangla Airlines Ltd. based in Dhaka, Bangladesh. The plaintiff is Bangladeshi-Canadian by nationality. The plaintiff has no assets registered in the Province of Ontario.

Judgment and Justification of the Appeal:

The plaintiff rented his vehicle to another Ontario resident and the vehicle ended up in Jim's Towing, Oshawa. The renters of the vehicle are responsible for the original cost of towing and storage. The renters did not full-fill this financial obligation and failed to pay the owner any rental fees and/or purchase of the vehicle out-right as offered by the owner. Jim's towing refused to release vehicle and claimed to have owned it. The owner sued the Towing/Storage company and renters, and I am satisfied with the evidence as presented.

The case can now proceed to Appeal as Justice dismissed the claim without fair trial.

Consequence:

Non-pecuniary damage of about \$60,000 CAD as claimed by Defendant (value of said property in 2024)
Pecuniary damage of about \$10,000 CAD as claimed by Plaintiff (his original loss in 2020)

Non-pecuniary damage arises as result of loss of income and refusal to release on part of the Defendant (justified by the defendant's own submission to court).

Pecuniary damage is the loss of the vehicle 2009 Infiniti G37xS (in 2020 dollars as originally claimed by the Plaintiff).
